NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) hereby informs all **HOLDERS of an Environmental Permit and/or Environmental Authorisation** which said Permits may have **Expired and/or to be Renewed**, to make immediate contact with the Agency's office no later than **February 28, 2019**.

Permit Holders are advised it is illegal under the Environmental Protection Act Cap. 20:05 and the Environmental Protection (Authorisations) Regulations 2000, to operate, construct and/or conduct developmental activities without a valid Environmental Permit and/or Environmental Authorisation.

Should Permit Holders fail to contact our office later than **February 28, 2019**, will result in immediate enforcement actions including termination of operation(s) being taken against you for non-compliance and operating without a valid Environmental Permit and/or Authorisation.

Your failure to comply with the stipulated date of this notice, will result in all permitting fees being retroactive from the date of your expired permit to the time of your renewal application.
